What are the proposed dates for which you are bidding?

November 30, 2018 through December 2, 2018

Does your proposed Smofcon have a theme?

What is your proposed convention host city?

- Is your convention site in a city center location or a suburb?

Santa Rosa, California 1.5 miles east of downtown

- If a suburb, what are the transport options into the city center? How far is the site from the city center?

Local bus system, site is about 1.5 miles from downtown Santa Rosa

What is the typical current airfare to your closest airport from world cities such as Auckland, Boston, Chicago, Dallas, Dublin, Helsinki, London, Los Angeles, Melbourne?

Closest airport doesn't have direct flights to anywhere except for Los Angeles on the list. Below is for one of the two major International airports, San Francisco. Oakland is the other.

No to international, yes to domestic (see below)

Oakland and San Francisco airports are about 1-1 ¼ hours away (depending on traffic)

- Which airlines service your airport?

Allegiant and Alaska Airlines now and American Airlines starting early 2017 service Santa Rosa Airport

- Are direct flights from the cities above flown into your local airport?

No, not to Santa Rosa airport – direct flights are from Seattle, Portland, Los Angeles, Orange County, San Diego, Las Vegas, Phoenix/Mesa, and Phoenix Sky Harbor

How far is your convention site from the nearest airport/train station and what is the likely cost of getting to the hotels by both public transport and taxi from that airport/train station?

Taxi from Santa Rosa airport about \$25 (15 miles)

Shuttle Bus (with Wi-Fi) from Oakland and San Francisco about \$32 (about 1 ¼ hours)

Will also host ride-sharing exchange for those who choose to rent a car at San Francisco or Oakland and drive in to the convention

What hotel(s) are being used for the convention?

Flamingo Resort Hotel

- How many rooms?

80 rooms peak currently in block, 170 rooms available

- How many Singles/Doubles/Kings?

60 Single/Double, 15 King, 5 Suites in block

- What other types of rooms are available? How many are handicap accessible?

4 ADA rooms available, 9 pet friendly rooms (with a \$50 non-refundable deposit)

- Are there any accessibility issues?

One small section of sleeping rooms don't have elevator service

- What are your hotel room rates?

\$129 Single/Double, \$149 Executive King, \$199 Suite

No

- Do they include internet in the room?

Yes, complimentary wi-fi in the guest rooms

Room rates and function room costs are contracted

What type of weather can we expect at the time of year your convention is to be held?
About 20% average chance of rain, low in the lower 40's, high in the upper 50's.

What are some of the main tourist attractions of your city?
Several hundred wineries (many of which have tours), the Charles M. Schulz Museum, Snoopy's Home Ice at the Redwood Empire Ice Arena, Luther Burbank Home and Gardens, Armstrong Redwoods State Reserve, several Casinos, Safari West wildlife preserve, San Francisco Bay cities nearby (less than an hour's drive south) with hundreds of additional attractions. We plan to sponsor a wine country bus tour/sampling the day before the convention.
